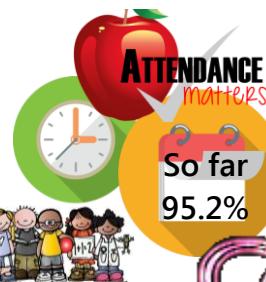


ASH GREEN WEEKLY NEWS


Our winners will receive a medal, certificate and a prize.

BREAK UP – BUFFET LUNCH – FRI 20th JULY


Children will enjoy a buffet lunch before we break up at 2.15pm.

GADGETS IN SCHOOL


On the last day of term children can bring a toy to school. This can be an electronic device as long as it cannot take photographs. This will be the responsibility of your child – please send a permission note in on the day.
