

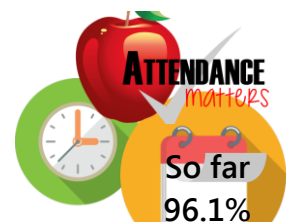

Ofsted Inspection

As you know, last Thursday and Friday we were inspected by Ofsted. The report will be published in December and information shared with parents then. What we can share now is that the inspectors were very complimentary about the way that staff, parents and pupils work together and conduct themselves and that our school has a very clear moral purpose that everyone shares. We will have many strengths- and some targets- but the recognition of the teamwork in our Community School is fantastic to hear.



Out Of The Ashes...

The school community was left devastated on Tuesday morning to discover that our Lower Site KS1 Outdoor Classroom had been set alight the previous night. This was a wonderful building which we used as a teaching and learning base but also a space where the children loved to play and talk during play and lunch sessions. We have worked closely with the police to try and get justice and welcome any information from the community who were so prompt to report the blaze: thank you. We have been absolutely blown away by the support from our school community. Parents and friends have raised considerable funds as soon as they heard of the damage. Of course we are pursuing an insurance claim (which may cover costs) to demolish and remove the old structure, then build a new one but please be assured that, having spoken to the parents who initiated the fundraising, the wonderful effort in raising money will be added to any insurance money we receive to ensure that 'out of the ashes' of disaster we have an even better place for your children to learn and play.
