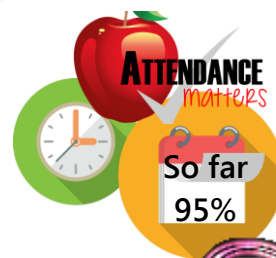


# ASH GREEN WEEKLY NEWS
