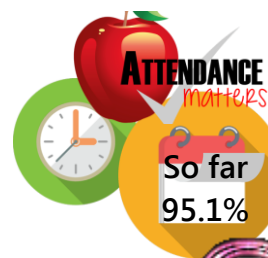


ASH GREEN WEEKLY NEWS
